This particular type of forklift truck should only be utilized on stable, level ground or on a prepared surface.

The trainee would learn to correctly lower and raise the load vertically and how to tilt the lift truck mast, moving the mast between 5 and 15 degrees both forwards and backwards. Individuals training would learn the RTITB standards needed for safe forklift operation. People training would likewise become familiar with the kinds of attachments for the forklift arms.

Types of Counterbalance Forklifts:

## Walkie Pallet Trucks
